About the Band

The Bavarian Musikmeisters is a nonprofit organization led by a board of five members and two co-directors. All monies collected by donations or earned through performances are used for the benefit of the band as a whole.

We perform at about 20 events a year including park concerts and at Germanic festivals and senior residences. In addition, there are 10 to 15 rehearsals and one or two social events during the year.

The band's instrumentation includes vocalist, flute, clarinet, trumpet, flugelhorn, tenor horn, baritone, trombone, tuba, and percussion.
